- Article extracted from research, thesis or essay must be marked by asterisk (*) on title and specified in footnote of first page.
- Articles must include title, abstract, keywords, introduction, text, conclusion and resources.
- Terms must be marked by numbers and mentioned in the article footnote.
- References must be placed in short between brackets (author's family, publishing year: page number) within article text, in case of immediate repetition of same reference, "Ibid" and interval repetition, "Op.Cit." are used. Resources arranged as bibliography are put in order alphabetically at the end of article.
- In case of book, author's family, name (publishing year), **Book Title**, translator's name and family, publishing place: publisher, edition time.
- In case of article: author's family, name (publishing year), "article's name", Translator name and family, **Journal Name**, publishing volume, Journal number, publishing season, pages numbers of article in Journal
- In case of website or other electronic sources: author's family, name (publishing or access date), translator's name and family, "subject title", site or **Electronic Source Address**.
- Articles submitted are published after evaluated and edited by Political Science Quarterly edition board and acceptance of Juries.
